

St. Paul's Building Project Update

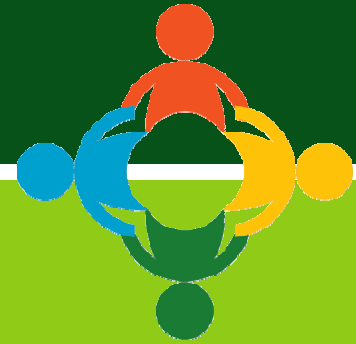
What we have wanted...

- To achieve the goals outlined by the parish we have re-visited the concept of a major renovation, demolition and partial expansion of the current building facilities.

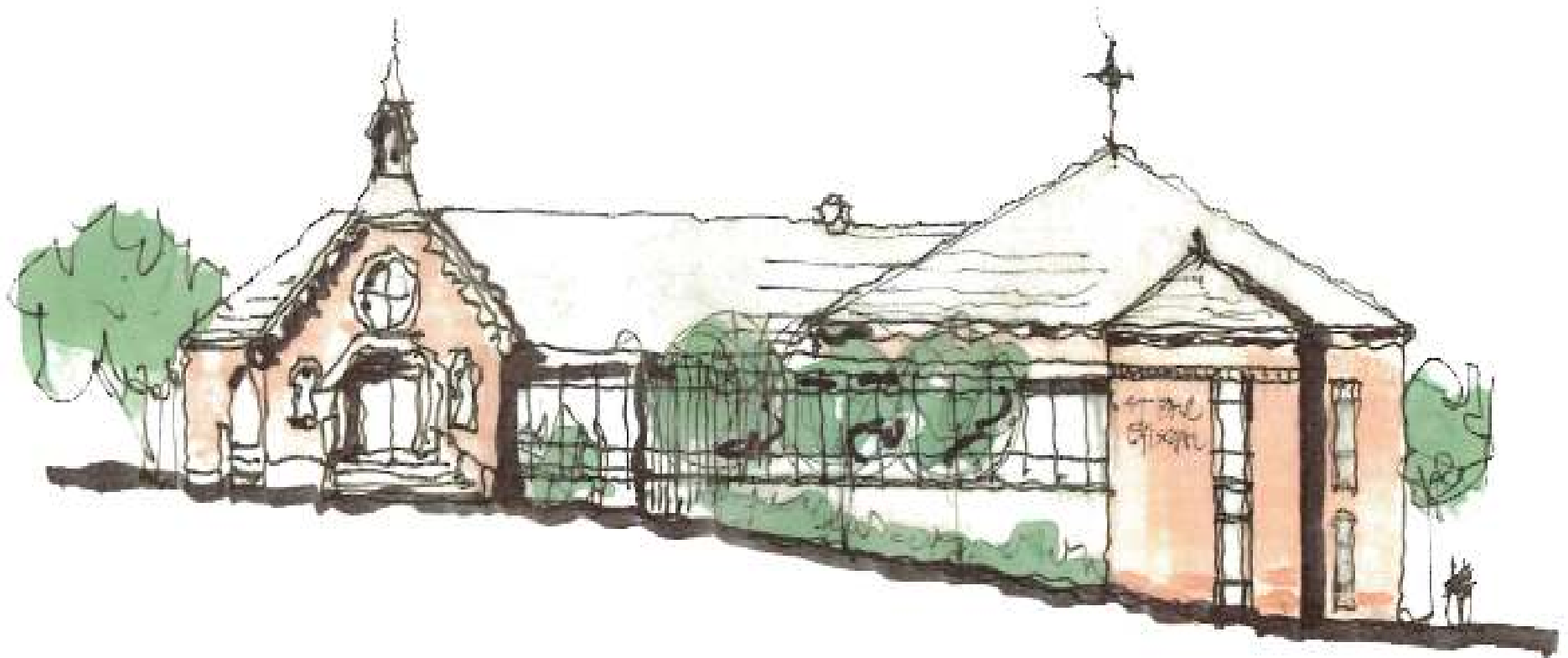

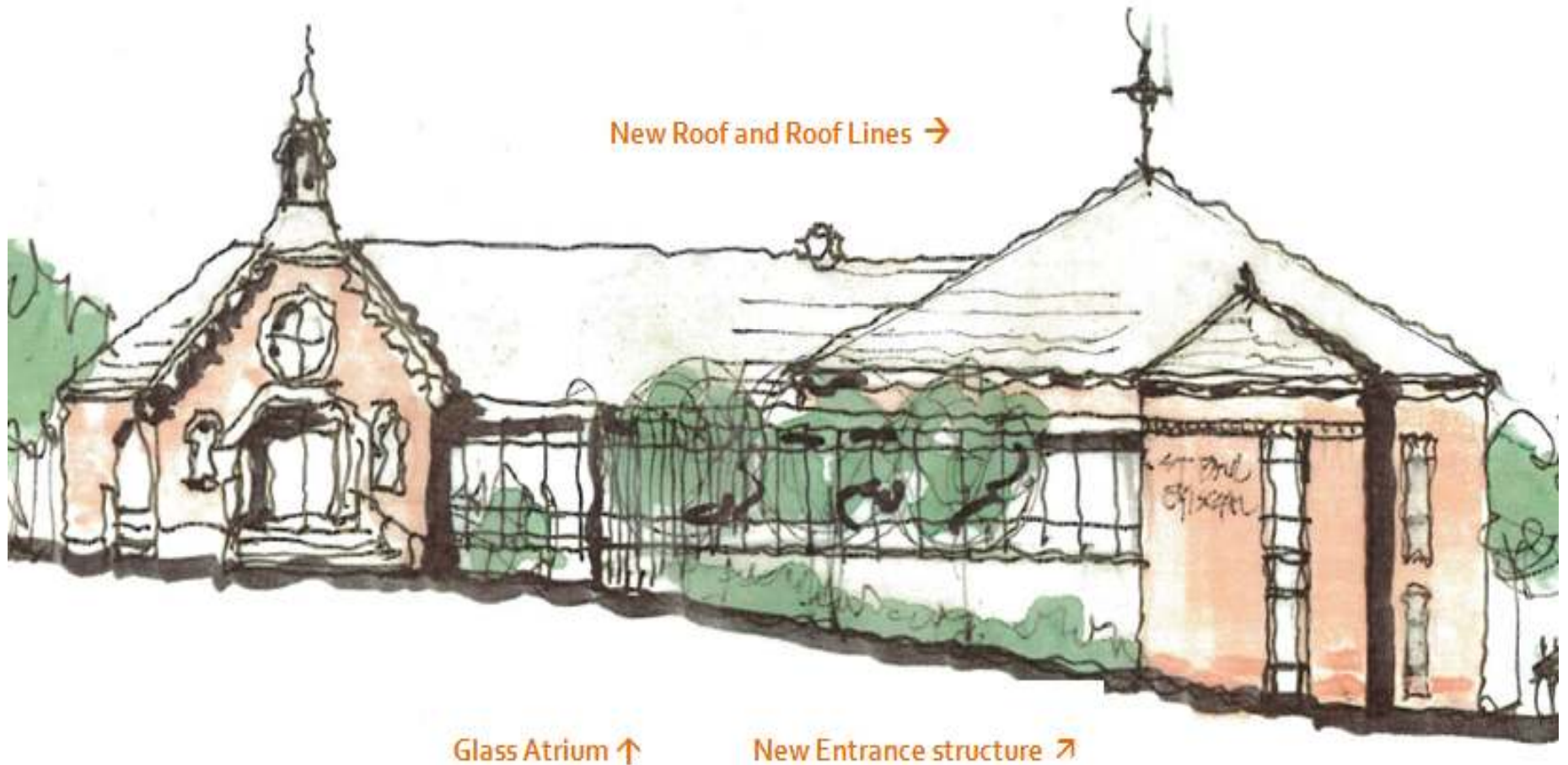
- \$350,000.00 Congregation

Revised Concept

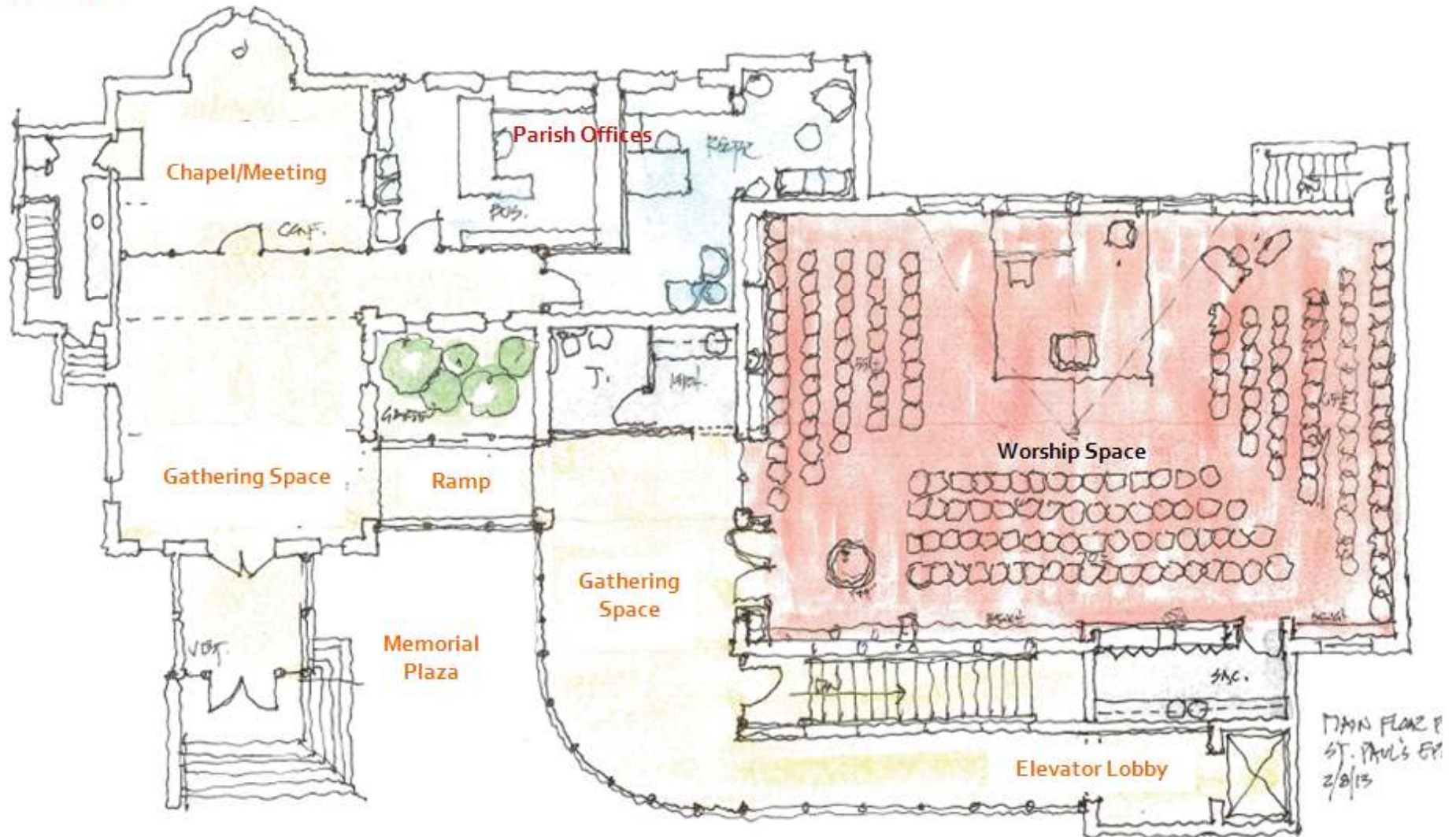


Highlights of Concept

MAIN LEVEL

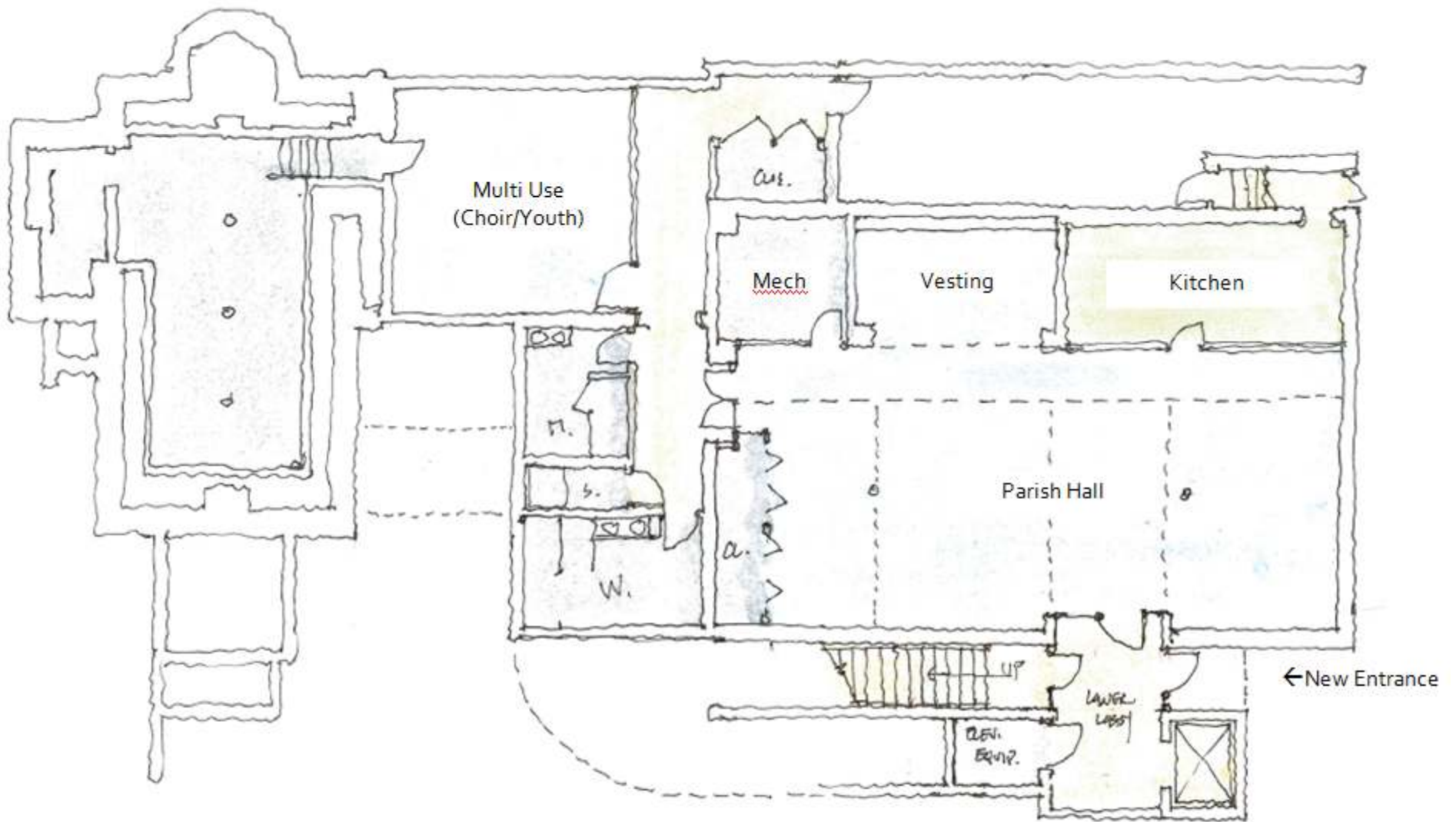


Highlights of Main Floor

- Repurposed education wing as main worship space (seating for 230-240)
- A portion of the Garth is maintained
- New glass enclosed gathering space atrium that speaks of "welcome"
- New and expanded sacristy
- Original building is maintained
- Original sacristy repurposed as Kitchenette and storage
- Creation of a "Memorial Plaza"

- A new unified Entrance on St. Paul Street
 - Expanded Parish Hall
 - Repurposed Vesting Room (formerly the Alcove)
 - Creation of a Multiuse Room (formerly the Noiroto/Youth Room)
 - Renovated Kitchen
 - Flexible Parish Hall for Classrooms
